

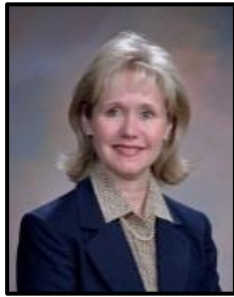

Sandra Shoemaker was appointed Vice President, Supply Chain Management Operations, for Lockheed Martin Aeronautics Company in August 2011. In this role, Mrs. Shoemaker focuses on strategic engagements with our supply base in a growing and complex material flow and supplier environment. She leads the Strategic Sourcing, Global Delivery System, Supplier Performance, Compliance, Operations, Contracts, Price Cost Analysis, and Supplier Diversity organizations. These organizations deliver support enterprise-wide.

Previously, Mrs. Shoemaker served as Vice President, Aeronautics Services, where she led the Government Relations, Integrated Operations, Media Products and Support Services, Facilities and Plant Engineering, and the Environment Health and Safety and Medical Services organizations. Prior to this role, Mrs. Shoemaker served as Vice President, Enterprise Resource Planning, where she led the OneAero project which transformed Finance, Global Sustainment and Supply Chain business processes and systems. Additionally, Mrs. Shoemaker has held other critical roles during her career, including Vice President, Program Management, where she was responsible for managing and improving the people, processes and tools associated with Program Management competencies, and Vice President of Integrated Company Operations, where she led the transition team efforts that merged three individual Lockheed Martin companies into a single entity. She also served in key Program Management roles on the F-16 Program.

Mrs. Shoemaker began her career with General Dynamics Fort Worth, and she has developed an in-depth knowledge of the company in Research and Engineering, Program Management, Operations, and Supply Chain Management. She holds a Bachelor of Business Administration in Finance and Economics from Baylor University and has attended several executive and advanced institutes.

Mrs. Shoemaker has been recognized for her accomplishments with several distinguished awards, such as the Women in Aerospace Award for Leadership and as one of Tarrant County's Texas Outstanding Women in Business. She has served as an advocate and executive sponsor for a variety of employee and civic organizations such as the Lockheed Martin Aeronautics Company Diversity Council in Fort Worth, the Lockheed Martin AERO Club, the Fort Worth Lockheed Martin Leadership Association (LMLA), and as Board President of the Lockheed Martin Recreation Association (LMRA).

As an active citizen in the community, Mrs. Shoemaker serves on Governor Perry's Advisory Committee on Aerospace and Aviation. She also supports academic institutions with her engagement in the University of Tennessee Global Supply Chain Institute Advisory Board, the Global Supply Chain Institute Advisory Board at TCU, the Baylor University Board of Advisors, and the Board of Directors for the Texas Business Education Coalition. She also is a member of the American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics (AIAA), the National Defense Industry Association (NDIA), the Project Management Institute (PMI), the International Test and Evaluation Association (ITEA), the Defense Acquisition University (DAU) Alumni Association, the Air Force Association (AFA), and Women in Aerospace (WIA).
