Dr. Priscilla Wisner holds a joint appointment with Graduate and Executive Education and the Department of Accounting and Information Management as a Distinguished Lecturer. She teaches accounting and finance at the Executive, MBA, and undergraduate levels. She is a core faculty member in the UT Global Supply Chain and the Aerospace and Defense Executive MBA degree programs, and in the Professional MBA program. Dr. Wisner also teaches in numerous non-degree executive programs, including programs focused on supply chain financial literacy and leadership tools for manufacturing management. She has taught custom programs for Eastman Chemical, Volkswagen, Hill Phoenix, Radio Systems Corporation, UT Medical Center, Covenant Health, and others. Dr. Wisner is also a faculty contributor to the *Accenture Supply Chain Academy*, developing and delivering programs on Linking Supply Chain Metrics to Economic Value, Working Capital Management, and Flexible Budgeting and Variance Analysis. Dr. Wisner has received outstanding faculty awards for both teaching and research.

Dr. Wisner holds a Ph.D. in business from the University of Tennessee, an MBA from Cornell University and her undergraduate degree is in international economics from the George Washington University. Dr. Wisner is experienced working with financial systems design and implementation, profitability analysis, and performance measurement systems. Prior to academia, she worked or consulted with firms such as Citicorp Information Management Services, American Management Systems, Bell Atlantic, and Sequoia and Kings Canyon National Parks. Prior to returning to her alma mater, Dr. Wisner taught at the Thunderbird School of Global Management and Montana State University. She has served as a visiting faculty member at National Economics University, Hanoi Vietnam and for Thunderbird in China. She has worked, taught in or managed academic programs in Europe, Mexico, South America, Vietnam and China.

Dr. Wisner's most current research is focused on international working capital management practices and outcomes related to organizational and supply chain management decisions. Her research has been published in a variety of outlets, including the *Journal of Operations Management*, *Management International Review*, *Advances in Management Accounting*, the *Harvard Balanced Scorecard Report*, *Behavioral Research in Accounting*, and *The Business of Sustainability*.
